is an approach to teaching our students, with the focus on preparing them for life after high school. Our goal is to ensure that our students are set up for success beyond graduation. Pathways ensures that each student walks away from their high school experience, ready to take on the next chapter of their lives, whether that is embarking on a college education, entering a tech school, or going straight into the work force.

A School Within a School

Every high school at GMCS contains a "School Of". A School Of is a set of specialty courses designed to give students knowledge and skills for a particular subject. There are 5 "Schools Of" within the 8 High Schools at GMCS:

Relevant Learning

Traditionally, every student is required to take Core Content Classes throughout their 4 years of high school. These Core Content Classes are English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. At GMCS, every student still takes these 4 Core Content Classes, but they are taught through the lens of their "School Of". For example, if a student is enrolled in the School of Media, they will learn about how Media applies to English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. If they are enrolled in the School of Engineering, they will learn about how Engineering applies to English, Math, Science, and Social Studies. This linked learning approach to education ensures that students stay more engaged and understand the relevancy of their Core Content Classes to their specialty "School Of" classes.
